This is a part-time Robotics Head Coaching position for someone with a background in robotics, programming, engineering, and/or a related field. The successful candidate will provide leadership and supervision of the AMHS Robotics Team, who will participate in the VEX Robotics program. This position reports to the AMHS Dean of Students and Director of School Administration. We are seeking a Coach who is enthusiastic about collaborating with high school students.

Qualifications:

- Ability to work with teenagers as a coach/mentor is essential.
- The ability to create a positive, cohesive team dynamic is as important as robotics knowledge.
- Qualified applicants will have some technology, engineering, and/or programming knowledge and/or previous experience coaching or supporting robotics or similar activities.

Preferred:

- Knowledge of VEX Robotics
- BA or higher in a STEM field or relevant robotics experience.
- Secondary teaching experience and a current Washington State Teaching certificate are preferred but not required for this role.

Compensation: A \$3,000 stipend. This position is not eligible for benefits.
